CE2C VOLUNTEER DENTIST

REPORTS TO: CE2C DENTAL SITE LEADER

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Partnering with Covenant Community Care, volunteer dental providers will staff dental trailers to go into our communities and provide free dental care to those who may not be able to afford it.

SPECIFIC DUTIES

1. The triage dentist will provide a dental screening which includes a head and neck exam. This dentist will direct care for the patient to extractions or debridement. They will summarize screening results, discuss follow up and provide or direct oral health education.
2. The second dentist (if available) will serve in the Ask a Provider station and answer very general health related questions, in order to point the guest to the proper care needed in the future.
3. The third dentist (if available) can remove diseased and infected teeth in the mobile dental room for a limited number of patients as available and dispense or prescribe or recommend medications as licensed.
4. The dentists will help with the set up and take down of the site.

All dental providers will:

5. Render first aid or refer for hospital emergency care as necessary (at patient's expense.)
6. Perform other duties as assigned by the Team Leader.
7. Uphold and advance the EACH and Covenant Community Care Mission Statements.
8. Comply with professional standards for service delivery.

1. Ability to function effectively as part of a team delivering healthcare in a community setting.
2. Knowledge of, and ability to adhere to, professional code of ethics.
3. Available at scheduled time and date(s).
