GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Partnering with Covenant Community Care, volunteer health care professionals will staff medical and dental trailers and related services to go into our communities and provide free medical care to those who may not be able to afford it.

SPECIFIC DUTIES

1. Medical Assistants and Nurses:

- Check and record pressures of each willing guest prior to them receiving other medical or dental services.
- Check and record weight, waist and hip circumference and calculate BMI and waist-hip ratio.
- Perform finger stick blood draw for glucose and optional total and HDL cholesterol testing.

2. Nurses:

- Conduct brief health history interview and assess eligibility for free cholesterol testing.
- Triage patients requesting or requiring a higher level of service including referral to physician or emergency care at a hospital.

3. All will:

- Perform duties as assigned by the Team Leader.
- Uphold and advance the EACH and Covenant Community Care Mission Statements.
- Render first aid as necessary and certified.
- Comply with professional standards for service delivery.

1. License/Certification in health related field of service as indicated.
